Prof. Puran Singh Best Thesis Cash Award

Rules and Regulations

Name of the Award: Prof. Puran Singh Best Thesis Cash Award to Ph.D. Scholars

Sponsor:

Dr. G.S. Randhawa, Former Professor, Department of Biotechnology,

Indian Institute of Technology, Roorkee.

Objective of the Award:

- 1. To provide recognition to outstanding original research done by doctoral degree students of FRI Deemed to be University.
- 2. To provide incentive for enhancing the quality of doctoral thesis research.
- **3.** To promote high quality doctoral thesis research in the area of Forestry.

Nature of Award:

This award is meant exclusively for Ph.D. Scholars of FRI Deemed to be University for doctoral thesis in Forestry. The Award shall be declared annually for one best thesis (to be commenced from 11.10.2018). Award shall consist of a citation and a cash of Rs. approx. Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty thousand only).

Eligibility:

- 1. Any Ph.D. Scholar of FRI Deemed to be University.
- 2. Applicant should have submitted their thesis and have got their Doctorate degree (either provisional degree duly signed by the competent authority of the university awarding the degree or the final award) in the given period.
- 3. The research work must be original and must have a direct bearing on some relevant aspects of the forestry.
- 4. The result obtained must have the potential of enhancing the production/ productivity/sustainability of the relevant Forestry system or substantially advance the knowledge.

Administration of the Award:

There shall be a Judging Committee consisting of 04 members appointed by Director, FRI & VC, and FRI Deemed to be University who will critically evaluate all submitted thesis and then submit their evaluation report to the University. Short listing of best theses will be on the basis of marks given by the Judges.

The experts will be provided soft copies of theses, synopsis, one page abstract and a format mentioning above criteria for evaluating the theses, in which they will provide the marks. The best thesis award shall be awarded on the basis of average of marks given by experts.

Director General, Indian Council Forestry Research and Education/Director, Forest Research Institute & Vice Chancellor, FRI Deemed to be University will present the award to the awardees on 26th January /15th August.

Evaluation Criteria:

Total number of marks shall be 100 with bifurcation as under:-

- 1. Conceptual clarity and coherence of the research problem (10 marks)
- 2. Originality & Innovation (10 marks)
- 3. Scientific, technological and socio-economic relevance and priority of the Research problem (10 marks)
- 4. Compilation, analysis and interpretation of existing literature, quality of illustrations and photographs (10 marks)
- 5. Organization of research work. Complementarily of the various experiments and investigations and their integration into a logical plan of work. (10 marks)
- 6. In what way the findings constitute a significant advancement in the knowledge and understanding (10)
- 7. Significance to the research community & its impact (14 marks)
- 8. Technical excellence (Rationale, objectives, methodology, study design, findings, clarity of the content, references and presentation) (14 marks)
- 9. Number of Publications including mandatory publications (12 marks)
